

COVID-19

As of 3 April 2022, ACT Health reports: The ACT continues to experience increased COVID-19 cases and high community transmission at levels resembling the peak in January 2022. Whilst we have seen case numbers trending down in the last week, we will continue to monitor the situation closely. Despite the ongoing high case numbers and PCR test positivity, hospitalisations and ICU admission continue to remain stable. Increased case numbers are likely the result of several factors, including increased social interactions and movements owing to relaxed public health and social measures, and increased incidence of the more transmissible BA.2 Omicron subvariant.




A picture of disability in the ACT <u>ACT Disability Strategy | YourSay ACT</u>
